Wonder Valley Christian Camp

The health and well-being of everyone who comes to our campus is important to us. We are continuously monitoring the COVID-19 situation and are making decisions based on the most up-to-date information available to us.

Refund policy

- If a camper's registration is cancelled by either the individual or WVCC, a full refund is possible. We will contact you to learn your wishes.

Check-In

- Health Check includes:
 - Temperature must be under 100F.
 - Lice check. We have a "no nit" policy.
 - Parent or camper will be asked to affirm that they have no symptoms of illness.

During Camp

- Buildings are cleaned and disinfected between each event.
- High traffic and high-touch areas cleaned regularly.
- Hand sanitizer stations available around campus.
- Hand soap and paper towels are available at every sink on campus.
- No visitors will be allowed this summer. Guests, invited by the Dean, are allowed, and must check in at the office.
- As usual, cell phones will not be permitted for campers.
- Anyone who exhibits signs of illness will be isolated and sent home.

Check-out

- Camper must be signed out from their dorm.

Note: There is an inherent risk of illness spreading through any camp setting.

- While we are doing all that is reasonable and prudent to maintain a healthy environment at camp, there is no way we can guarantee complete safety.
- The session will not be ended early unless there are multiple cases of illness.
- **By sending your child to camp you are accepting the risks.**
